The amendments are necessary in order to consolidate this land with the adjacent private land (west) to create an additional residential lot, to front onto Spencer Street. **MOTION CARRIED.**

2. No more than 4 suites/rooms may be permitted to be rented.

3. There shall be a parking space for each available room that can be rented in addition to the minimum parking being maintained for the dwelling/owners suite.

4. The Bed and Breakfast shall be occupied by the property owner or B&B host and they must reside in the dwelling for the duration of the rental periods.
