## 16-051 <u>Municipal Plan Amendment 15-06 and Development</u> <u>Regulations Amendment DR15-06</u>

On motion by Councillor J. Carey, seconded by Councillor K. Cormier it is RESOLVED under Section 16 of the Urban and Rural Planning Act, the Corner Brook City Council adopt Municipal Plan Amendment MP15-06 to:

Amend policy 4.5.3.17 (General and Light Industrial Areas - Uses) of the 2012 Integrated Municipal Sustainability Plan by including general assembly uses, limited to gymnasia, bowling alleys and other similar indoor recreational facilities, as a use that may be permitted in industrial areas when the use may be considered compatible with adjacent industrial uses, or will not adversely affect the functioning of industrial uses or result in a conflict of land uses. MOTION CARRIED

On motion by Councillor J. Carey, seconded by Councillor K. Cormier it is **FURTHER RESOLVED** under section 16 of the Urban and Rural Planning Act, the Corner Brook City Council adopt Development Regulations Amendment MP15-06 to:

1. Permit the "amusement" classification of use as a discretionary use of the General Industrial use Zone Table by adding the classification to the Discretionary Use Class Table of the Zone.

2. Permit the general assembly" classification of use as a discretionary use of the General Industrial Use Zone Table by adding the classification to the Discretionary use Class Table (with an asterisk) of the zone and by adding a new condition which limits examples of the use classification to gymnasia, bowling alleys and other similar indoor recreational/fitness facilities.

3. Permit the "general assembly" classification of use as discretionary use of the Light Industrial Use Zone Table by adding the classification to the Discretionary Use Class Table of the zone and by adding a new condition which limits examples of the use to indoor recreational facilities such as gymnasia, including climbing apparatus and or facilities, bowling alleys, and similar recreation and fitness users. **MOTION CARRIED.** 

## 16-052 <u>Municipal Plan Amendment MP16-01 and Development</u> <u>Regulations Amendment 16-01 (Georgetown Road for a single</u> <u>lot)</u>

On motion by Councillor M. Murphy, seconded by Deputy Mayor B. Staeben it is RESOLVED, under Section 16 of the Urban and Rural Planning Act, the Corner Brook City Council adopt Development Regulations Amendment DR16-01 to change the land use designation of land off Georgetown Road from Light Industrial to Residential.

On motion by Councillor M. Murphy, seconded by Councillor T. Buckle it is FURTHER RESOLVED, under Section 16 of the Urban and Rural Planning Act, the Corner Brook City Council adopt Development Regulations Amendment DR16-01 to change the land use zoning of land off Georgetown Road from Light Industrial to Residential Medium Density. **MOTION CARRIED.**
