Canada Post is notifying customers of a possible labour disruption that could impact mail delivery. In the event of a labour disruption at Canada Post, Corner Brook residents are advised to not send payment for City taxes, invoices or other information through the mail.

Residents are urged to use alternative methods of submitting payment, invoices, or information which include the following:

- Online banking
- Telephone banking
- In person at City Hall 5 Park Street, from 8 a.m.-5:00 p.m. business days. Cash, cheques, preauthorized payment and debit are accepted
- Deposit box is located at City Hall near the parking lot entrance
- Courier

Payments are due by the date indicated on your notice. Late payment fees will not be waived.
