The City of Corner Brook is currently accepting applications for the Full-Time position of **Head Lifeguard**. As the Head Lifeguard, you are responsible for the day-to-day leadership and direction of the pool operation and aquatics program. The Head Lifeguard will be responsible for efficient operation of the aquatic's facility including planning, staffing, and operations, while ensuring a safe environment for participants.

Responsibilities will include, but not be limited to, assisting the Supervisor of Recreation, Aquatics with the planning, developing, organizing, and implementing of aquatics programming; Assisting with the hiring and performance management of lifeguard staff; Supervising pool activities and the safety of patrons at both the Corner Brook Regional Recreation Centre and Margaret Bowater Park, by ensuring facility rules and regulations are followed; take the lead during aquatics incidents, completing required rescue techniques, documentation and debriefing, etc.; Developing and overseeing the lifeguard schedule and payroll for lifeguards; Champion safety at all times and adhere to site-specific health and safety plans to mitigate or eliminate risks to you, the clients, and pool staff; Assist with ensuring pool water chemistry is maintained and in accordance with applicable legislative standards, including but not limited to, daily water sampling; Develop and conduct aquatic Training, including but not limited to, lifeguard training and swimming lessons.

The Head Lifeguard must possess current Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard Service Certification, First Aid and CPR, Lifesaving Society Swim Instructor Certification and Lifesaving Society Instructor Certification. The successful candidate will possess, or be willing to obtain, the Certified Pool Operator's (CPO) Certification, and be proficient in the use of computers and computerized systems.

A current Royal Newfoundland Constabulary (RNC) Certificate of Conduct and Vulnerable Sector Check is a requirement of this position along with a valid class 5 driver's license for the province of Newfoundland & Labrador.

The City of Corner Brook will provide support throughout the recruitment process to applicants with disabilities, including accommodation that considers an applicant's accessibility needs.
